Northfield school does not require parents or pupils to sign a 'Home-school agreement'. Our expectations and commitments are clearly expressed in our policy documents, letters and other guidance materials. Information is shared through our website and is discussed at length during the referral and transition programme. Expectations and commitments of the school, pupils and parents form a routine element of the EHCP review meetings for all pupils and their families/carers. Expectations and commitments are consistently reinforced through the tutoring programme and, where necessary, through the management of behaviour, attitudes or attendance by teachers and school leaders.

Northfield values the voice of the pupils and parent; these are actively sought, recorded and acted upon as part of the EHCP review cycle. Our tutors take an active role in seeking parental support and commitment through the routine use of reports, telephone calls, home visits and meetings. Pupils and parents are aware of the option to request a meeting, to make a complaint or to share views through a range of media or in person at any time.
